The state of Florida has changed the name of the Child Development Associate Equivalency Credential to Florida Child Care Professional Credential. The FCCPC is issued by the Child Care Program Office, Department of Children and Families, once the classes have been completed and other requirements have been met.

FCCPC: Observation

Students will learn how to examine various observation and recording techniques and develop individualized learning plans for each child.

Florida Child Care Professional Credential Renewal

As of June 30, 2005, all individuals working in a child care facility with a Florida CDAE/FCCPC or National CDA must complete the renewal process every five years to maintain an active credential. This 45-hour, 4.5-CEU course will meet the course requirement to apply for the renewal certificate. Topics include school readiness, literacy, curriculum exploration, learning through play, setting up the learning environment, and problem resolution.
