

OPEN FOR BUSINESS

The Early Learning Coalition of Marion County provided additional resources to child care providers to support our community's youngest learners as the community continued to feel impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic.

CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE AND RELIEF SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS (CRRSA)

Over \$3 million in federal grant funding was provided to child care providers who served families through the pandemic.

AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA)

\$1.8 million in additional federal funding was provided to operating child care businesses to assist them during the COVID-19 crisis.

PROVIDER STABILITY SUPPORT FUNDS

School Readiness child care providers received further financial support from ELCMC in February 2022.

PROVIDER REIMBURSEMENT RATE INCREASE

The ELCMC Board of Directors received approval from the FL Division of Early Learning to increase the base rate paid to School Readiness contracted child care providers by an average of 33%. The rate increase went into effect on March 1, 2022.
